

Other nearby areas for first class amenities such as independent shops, banks, supermarkets, eateries and more, include the affluent villages of Dorridge, Knowle and Henley-in-Arden.

Families moving to Blythe Valley will find there is an excellent choice of schools, all within a 15 minute drive. Busy Bees Nursery is within Blythe Valley Park which is perfect for working parents, while primary options include Cheswick Green Primary School, St Patrick's C of E Primary Academy and Hockley Heath Academy - all rated 'Good' by Ofsted. As for older children, Arden Academy and Tudor Grange Academy boast an 'Outstanding' Ofsted rating, while Alderbrook School is another great choice. For private schooling, choose from Solihull or Ruckleigh School, catering for both boys and girls or St Martin's School for girls.

For further education, there is the Solihull College and University Centre, while The University of Warwick, the University of Birmingham (the UK's 4th largest) and Aston University, are also close at hand.

Bloor Homes at Blythe Valley has the great advantage of being close to the heart of the UK's motorway network. Junction 4 of the M42 is just minutes away, with direct links to M5 (for the southwest), M40 (for the south) and M6 (for the northwest), giving you easy access to Birmingham, Birmingham International Airport, Warwick, Coventry, Leamington Spa, Manchester and London.

For train travel, the closest stations include Dorridge, Widney Manor and Solihull, with regular trains to Birmingham (*Moor Street - fastest route 8 mins*), Leamington Spa (*fastest route 16 mins*) London (*Marylebone – fastest route 1 hr 30 mins*), plus services around the West Midlands region.

There is a shuttle bus from Blythe Valley Park to Solihull and Birmingham International train stations, while the 20 bus from Stratford-Upon-Avon runs every hour (during peak times) to Birmingham City Centre. The A7 / A8 bus provides regular services to Cheswick Green, Hockley Heath and Dorridge train station, while the nearest airport is Birmingham International, just 9 miles away.



With excellent transport links, your choices for adventure are limitless. With plenty of days out within close proximity from Bloor Homes at Blythe Valley, the choices are endless. Choose from family meals out at quaint local restaurants such as The Farm and Blue Bell Cider House, to a trip to the popular National Motorcycle Museum (13 minute drive) or National Trust's, Baddesley Clinton and Packwood House - both of which are just a 10 minute drive away.

Being so close to the centre of the country means that Bloor Homes at Blythe Valley is also perfectly placed for days out in historic cities like Warwick and Stratford-on-Avon and favourites such as Birmingham, and Leamington Spa.




